Hospital District 304 Commissioner Vacancy

United General District 304 is seeking nominations to fill a vacancy on its Board of Commissioners.

**Nomination Notice Period:
December 20, 2024 through January 5, 2025**

At its December 18, 2024 regular meeting, the Board of Commissioners of United General District 304 accepted Commissioner Tina Tate’s resignation effective January 31, 2025. The Board then nominated Debra Lancaster to fulfill Commissioner Tate’s term (Position 3) through November 30, 2024.

Registered voters in Skagit County Hospital District No. 304 may also nominate persons to fulfill the term during the *nomination notice period*.

Candidates must reside within the boundaries of District 304 and have a strong desire to improve the health and wellbeing of the residents in the communities it serves. The time requirements of this position include, but are not limited to, a monthly board meeting of approximately 1.5 hours, various committee meetings of one to two hours each and occasional community events promoting United General District 304’s programs.
