



Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to have your student participate in the Peer 2 Peer (P2P) Education Regional Training held at the Northwest Educational Service District 189 in Anacortes (1601 R Ave, Anacortes, WA 98221).

The training date will depend on your student's grade level

- **High School Students:** Monday, October 26th
- **Middle School Students:** Thursday, November 19th

The training is a day for youth to build their confidence as a group to become Peer Educators. This will be a full day of skill building, practicing those skills, and creating an action plan as a group.

During the training, youth will interact with other youth leaders from the northwest region, connect with each other during teambuilding activities, and build skills and confidence through facilitated workshops. This training is being provided FREE to your child, including lunch. Although this event is provided at no cost, we are asking youth for a strong commitment to attend as the value of the training is estimated at \$250 per participant, and registration is limited.

To ensure your student is able to attend this event, please complete the online parent/guardian permission forms and student registration. Step-by-step instructions for completing the forms and registration are included on the following pages. If you need a paper copy of the permission forms, please contact the training coordinator for assistance.

How to Register for Peer 2 Peer

Step 1: Connect with your school's Peer 2 Peer Advisor.

Let your school's Peer 2 Peer Advisor know that you are interested in attending a training. Once your advisor confirms that you will attend with their group, a parent or guardian can complete the registration process on Civic Plus.

Parent/Guardian Registration Information

The following steps will need to be completed by a parent or guardian.

2) Sign in to your Civic Plus account.

If you don't have one, you will need to make one for yourself.

3) Find the Peer 2 Peer Training Listing

Peer 2 Peer is a youth cannabis and tobacco prevention program created by United General District 304 staff to train high school and middle school students as peer educators for their community.

Groups of students attend a free and fun all-day training alongside their adult advisor. During this training, students will be equipped with the knowledge, tools, and presentation skills to teach younger peers and community members about topics such as prevention science, media literacy, stress and anxiety coping mechanisms, the effects of cannabis and tobacco, and much more!

Since its creation in 2019 the Peer 2 Peer program has successfully trained over 600 students and their adult advisors from across the 5-County North Sound Region.

5) Add your child to your account.

If your child is not already linked to your Civic Plus account, click “add account member” and enter their information. Once added, select the box next to your child’s name and click “add to cart”

6) Review your cart and check-out.

After adding to cart, a pop-up window will appear. Select “Checkout” to continue.

7) Complete the registration questions.

Answer the prompts on the registration page and click the green “submit responses” button.

8) Review and accept the required agreements.

Read the Youth Recreation Waiver and Release. If you agree to the terms, select “I agree on behalf of [child’s name]” box and input your signature. Next, read the Youth Code of Conduct. If you agree to the terms, select “I agree on behalf of [child’s name]” box and input your signature. Once both boxes are selected, click the green “Confirm Waiver Agreement” button.

9) Complete the transaction.

This training is FREE, so no payment is required. Click “complete transaction” to continue.

10) Confirm your registration.

Review your registration details and click “complete transaction” again to finish.

You’re all set!

Your student is now registered for the Peer 2 Peer training. You should receive an email confirmation with your registration receipt.
